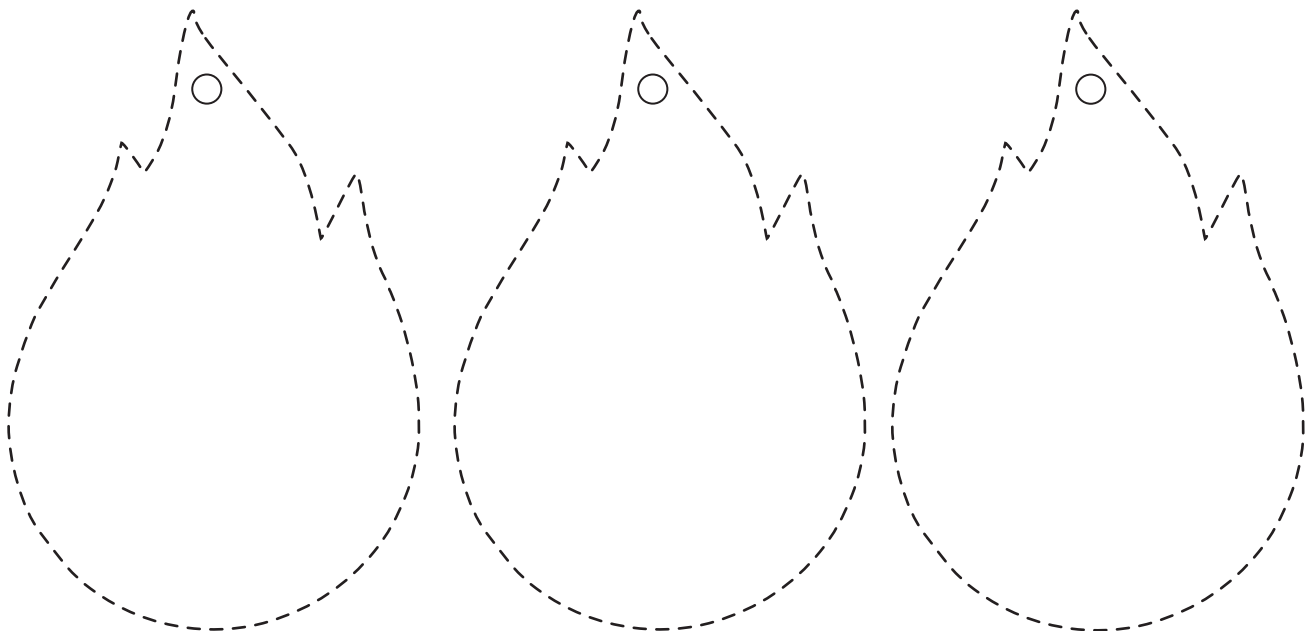
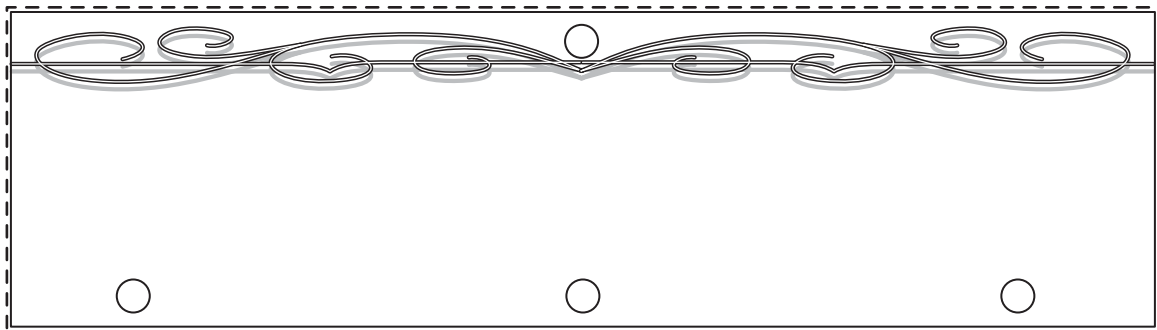


Holy Spirit in Motion
