

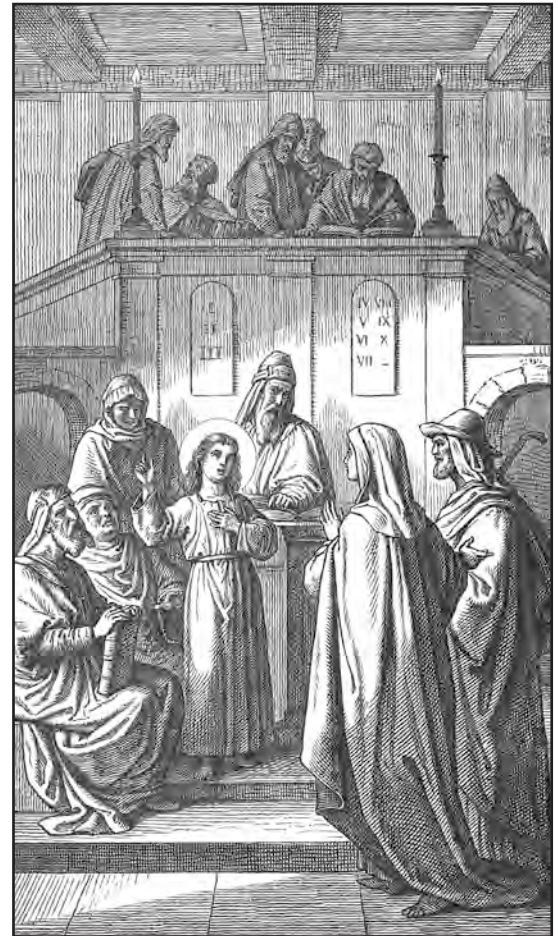


Luke 2:41–52

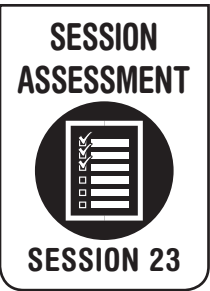
