Jesus is laid in the tomb.

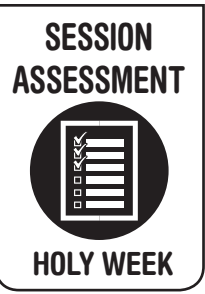
