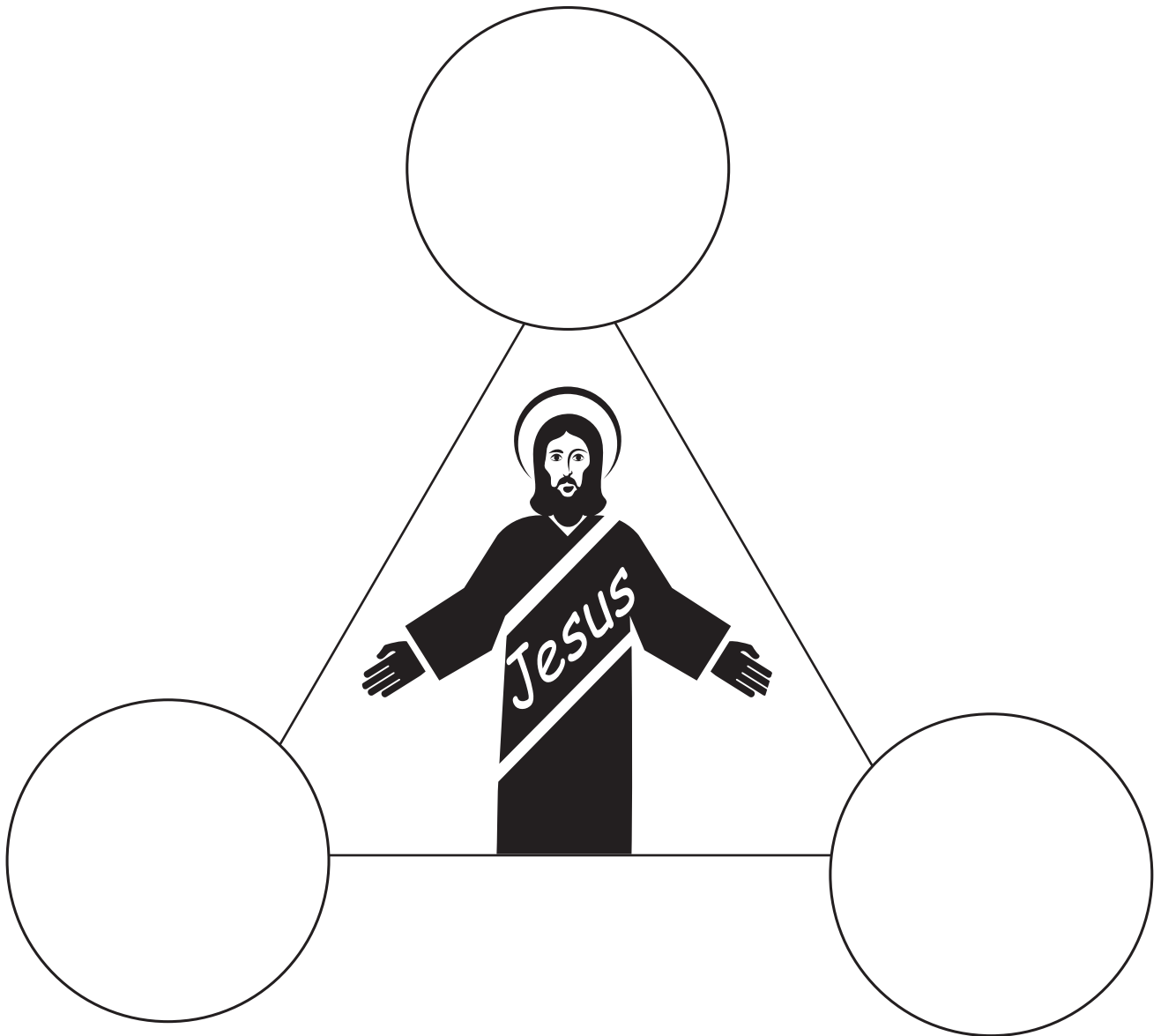




# John 1:35–39

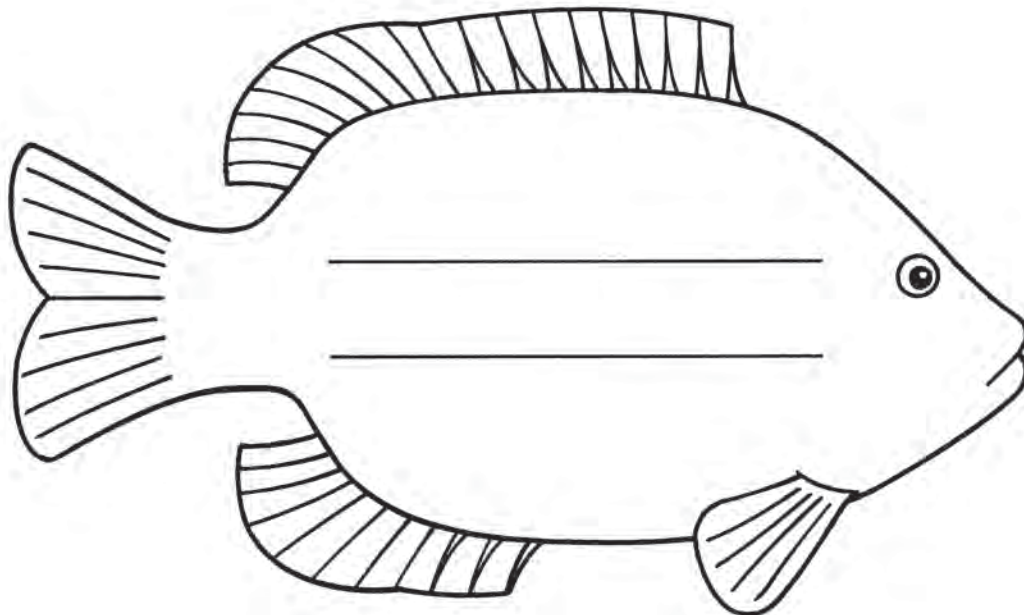
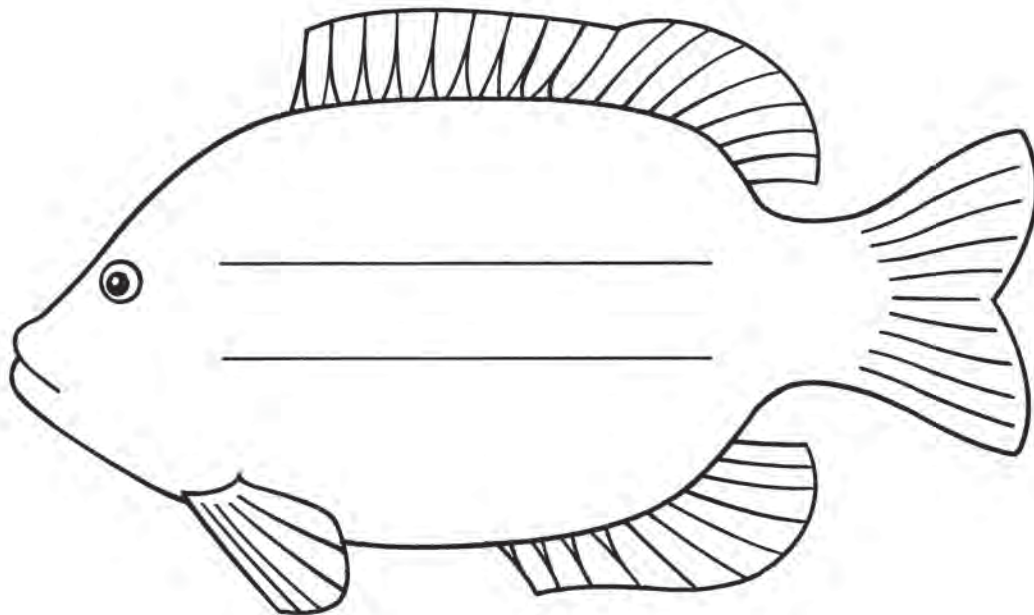
