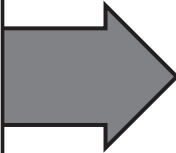


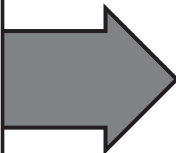
Isaiah 9:5–6

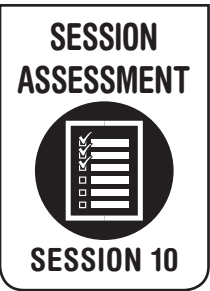
