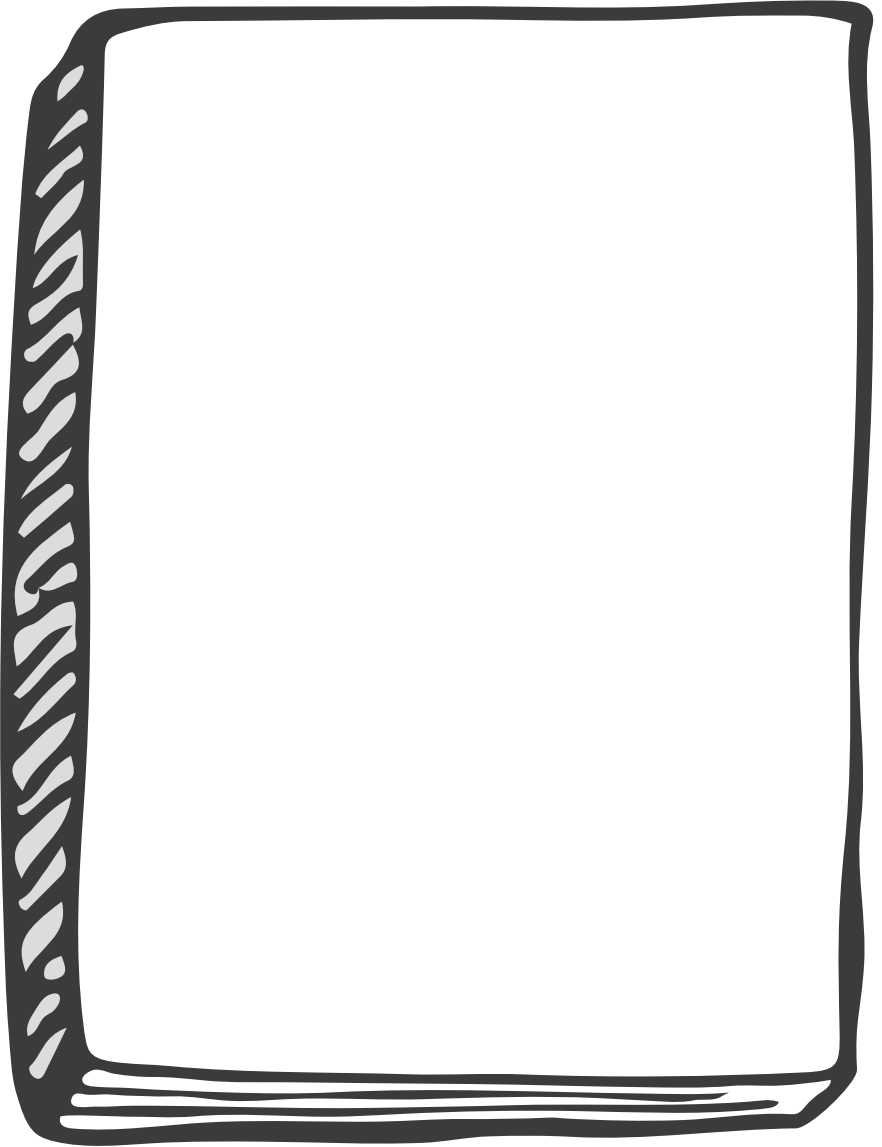




Genesis 2:21–24
