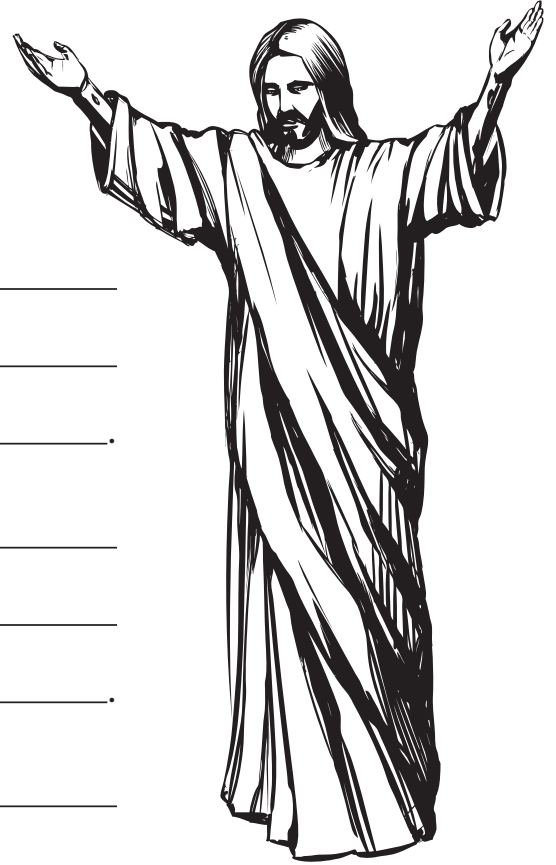


Ephesians 4:17-24
