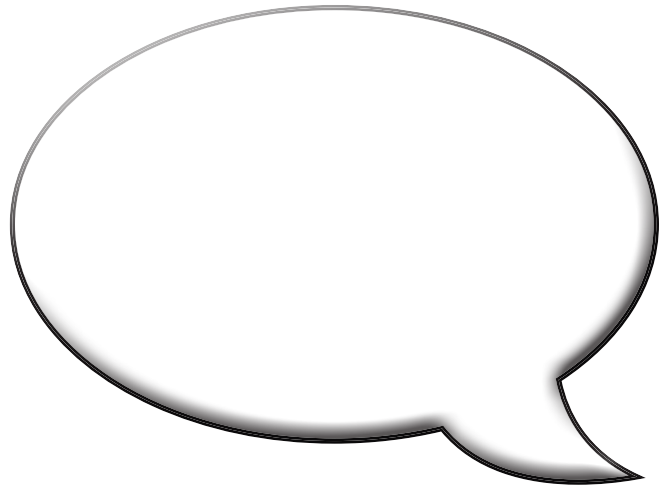
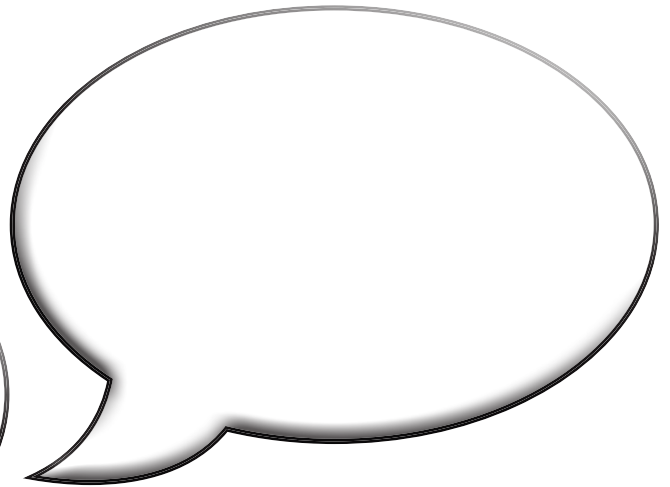
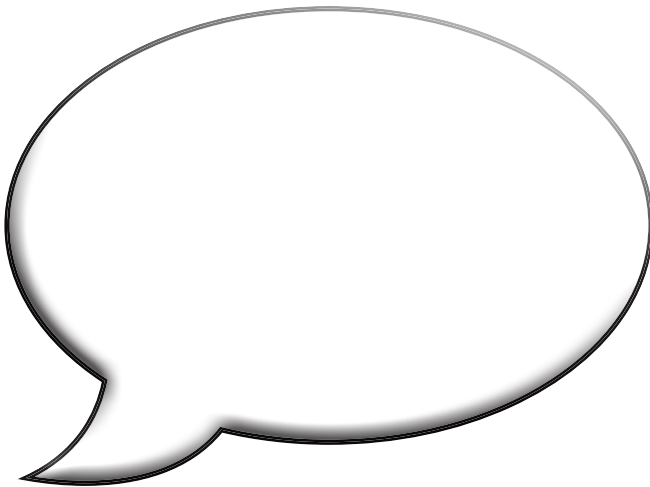




## Luke 9:1–6
