

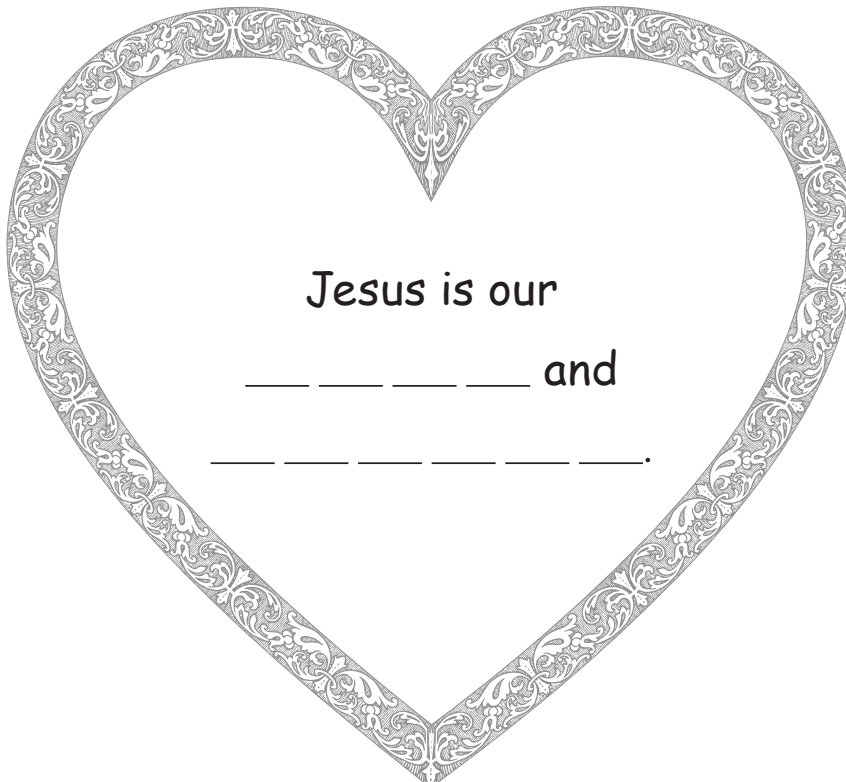


John 14:23–26
