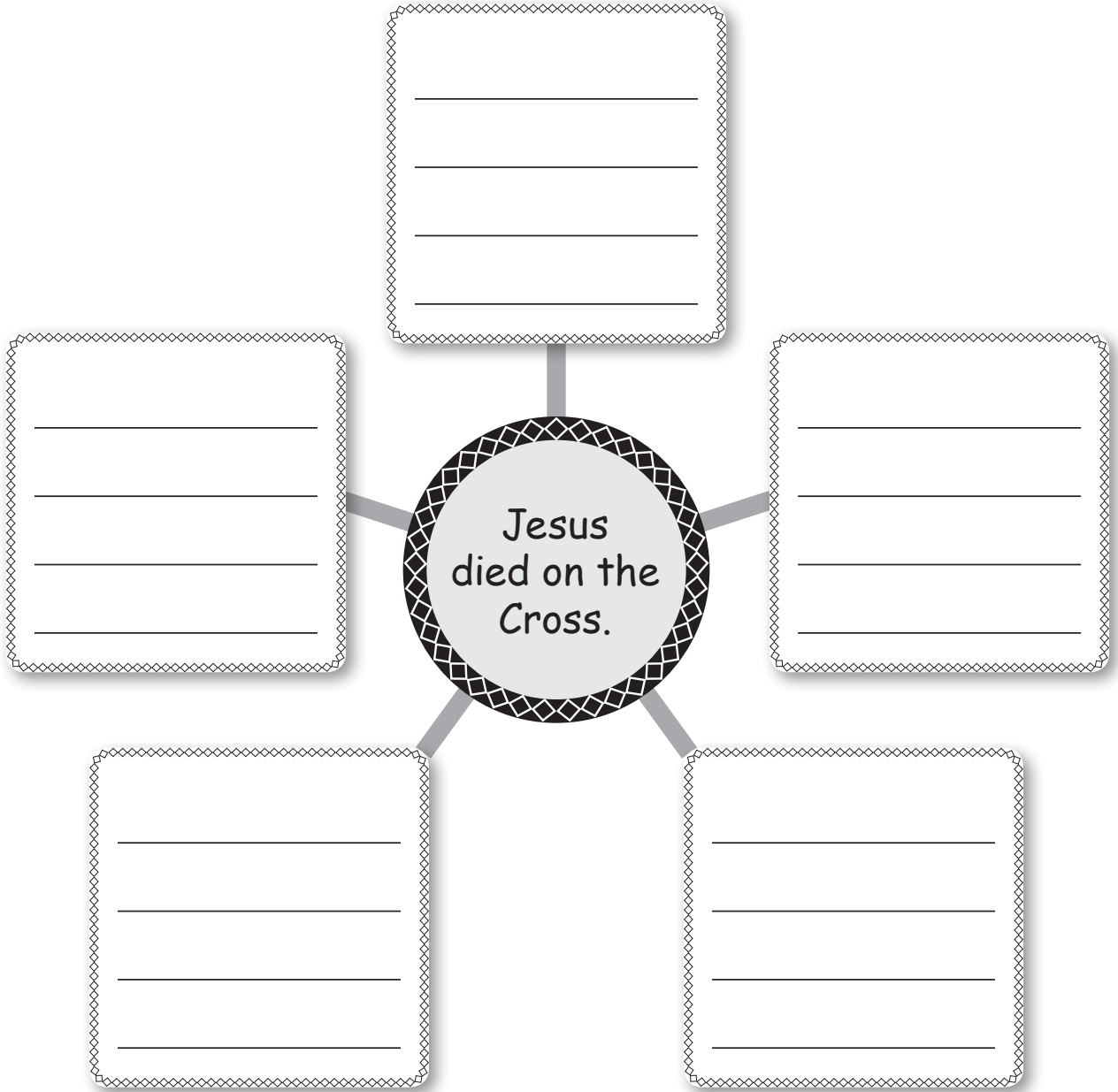




Mark 15:33–41

The Life of Jesus

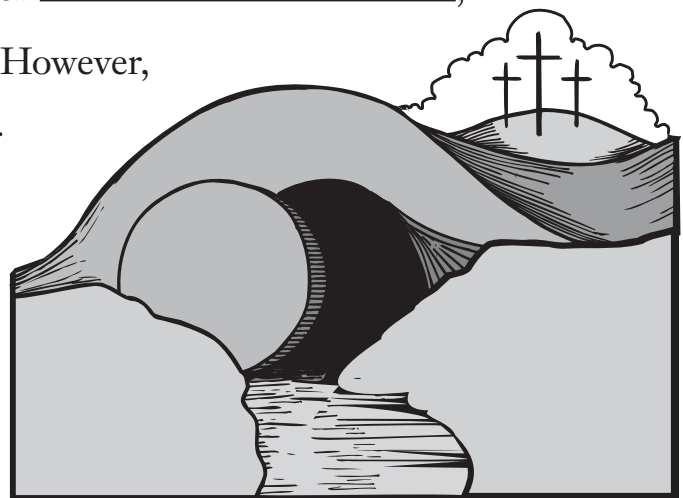

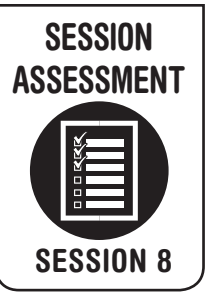
