

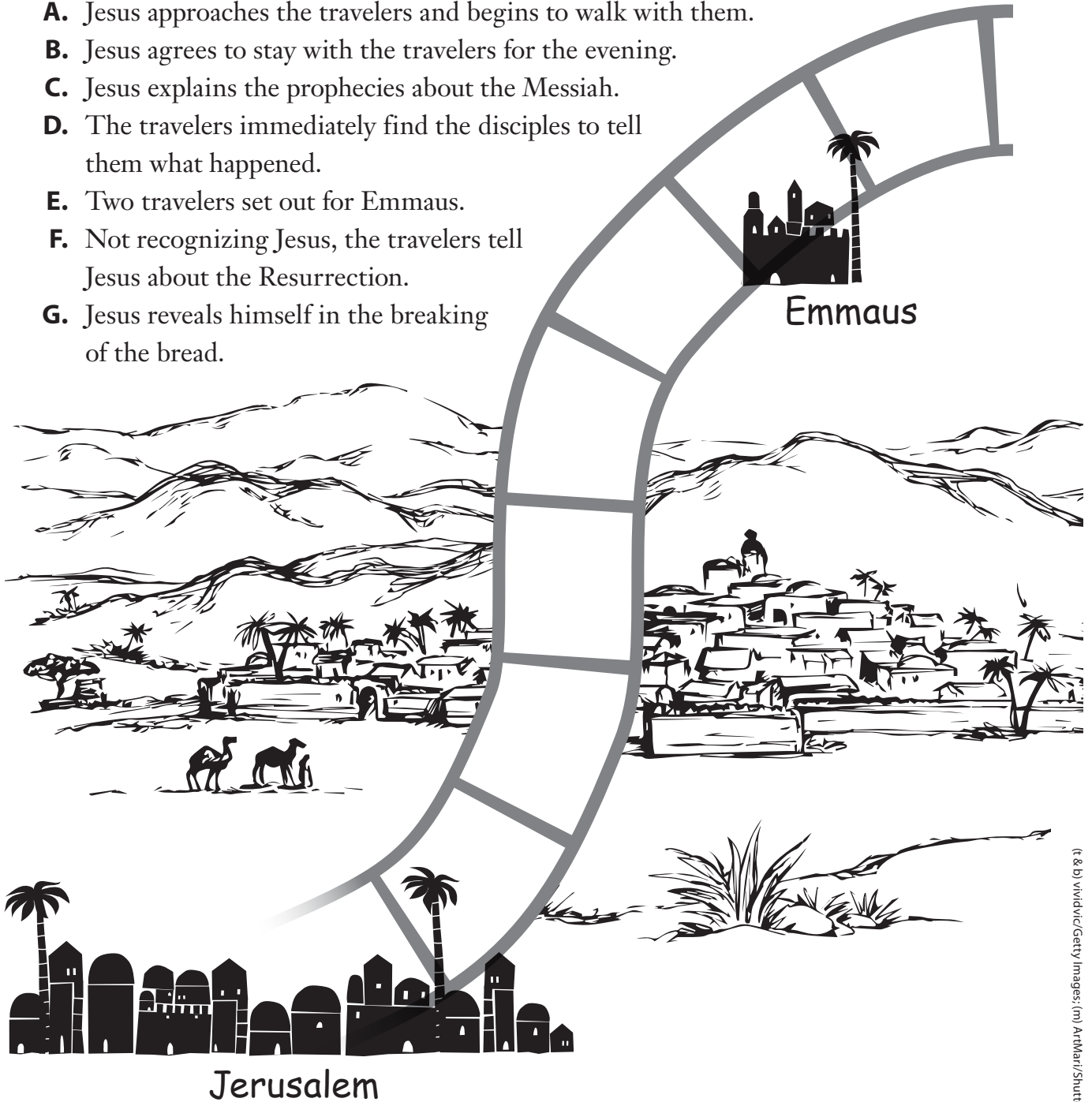


# Luke 24:13–35
