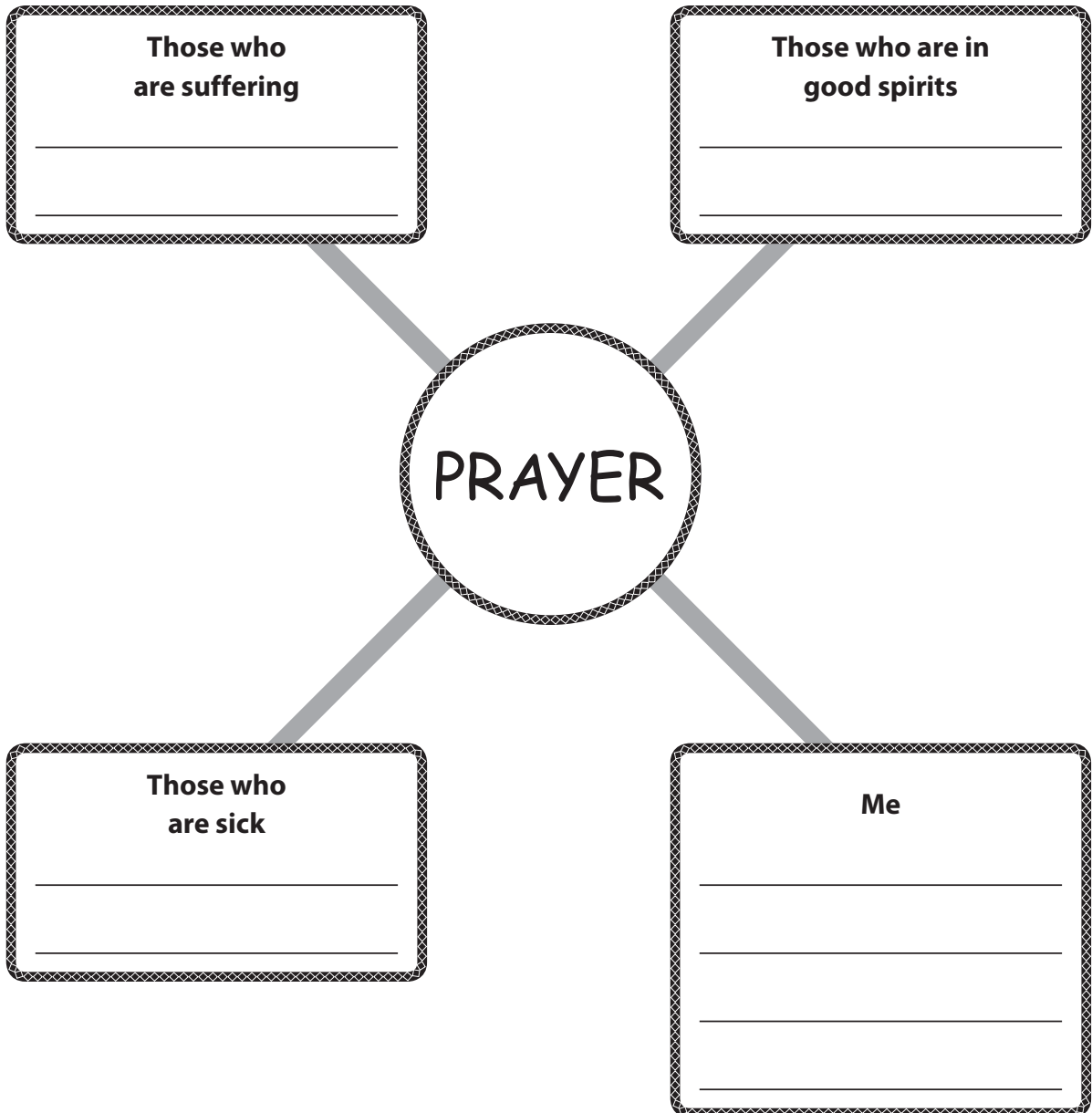


James 5:13–15

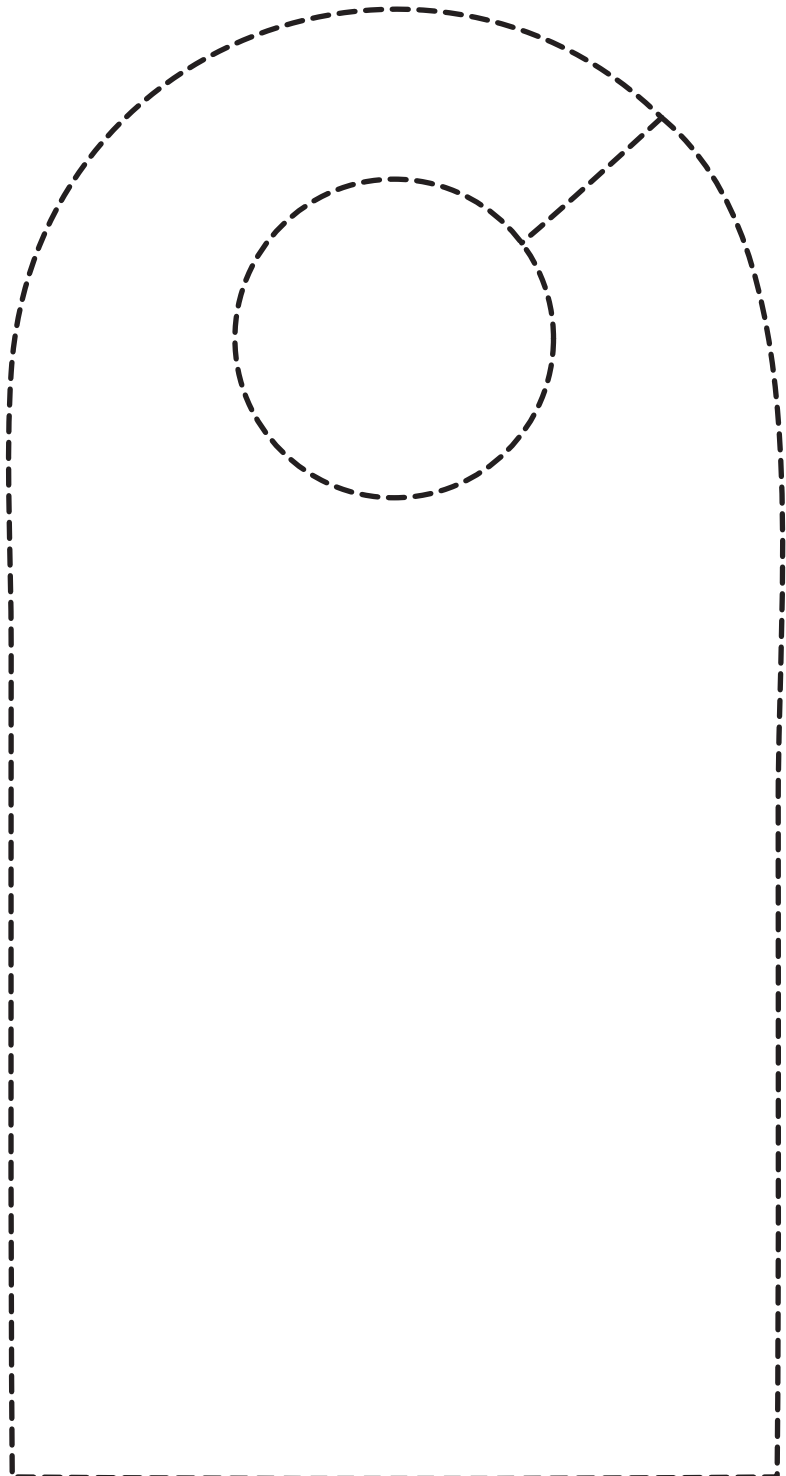




A Reminder to Pray

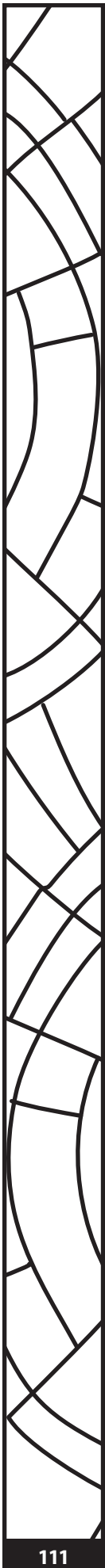
