### BAPTISMS:

Sundays: 1:30pm, twice a month. The Church calls GODPARENTS, to be practicing Catholics, examples of Christ-centered living today. All Godparents should submit Sponsor letters from their Parish ASAP. PARENTS must attend a Baptismal Preparation Session. (Registration is required.)

### MARRIAGES:

Arrangements must be made at least one year in advance. Either the bride or groom must be a registered member of our parish. Once the marriage questionnaire is completed a Parish Priest or Deacon will then contact the couple.

### ANOINTING OF THE SICK:

In case of serious illness or accident, phone the Pastoral Center. A communal celebration of the Sacrament is held each year in the Spring.

Individual Confessions on Saturdays at 12:30pm in the Church or by appointment by calling the Parish Office.

## Eucharistic Adoration



Eucharistic Adoration is the act of worshipping God as He is present in the consecrated Eucharist. Since the Last Supper, when Jesus broke the bread and distributed the wine saying, "This is my Body" and "This is my Blood," Catholics have believed that the bread and wine are no longer merely baked wheat and fermented grape juice, but the actual living presence of the Second Person of the Trinity—Jesus Christ. Spending time before the Blessed Sacrament, in prayer and devotion, is exactly the same as spending time before the Living God. Adoration occurs whenever someone kneels in front of a tabernacle that contains the Blessed Sacrament, genuflects toward a tabernacle, bows before receiving the Blessed Sacrament at Mass, or, in a more focused way, when the Blessed Sacrament is exposed for Adoration. **Join us on July 3rd, for Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament** Please come and embrace Jesus in which you say to Him: "I am yours, and I ask you, please stay with me always."

**June 28, 2026 - Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time  
Choosing to Follow Christ**

This week brings us readings that speak about welcome, faith, and commitment. Each passage reminds us that following God changes how we live. It calls us to trust His promises, live in new life, and place Him first in our hearts. In the first reading, we hear of a woman who welcomed the prophet Elisha into her home. Her kindness was rewarded with the gift of a son. This shows how God blesses those who open their lives to others. Hospitality is more than a simple act. It becomes a way to share God's love. The Gospel message is about choosing Christ above all else. Jesus tells his followers that their love for him must come before even family ties. This is not easy, but he also promises that even small acts of kindness, like giving a cup of water, have great value. This Sunday, we are reminded that faith touches both big choices and small actions. To follow Jesus is to place him at the center and to live with open hearts.
