BAPTISMS:

Sundays: 1:30pm, twice a month. The Church calls GODPARENTS, to be practicing Catholics, examples of Christ-centered living today. All Godparents should submit Sponsor letters from their Parish ASAP. PARENTS must attend a Baptismal Preparation Session.

MARRIAGES:

Arrangements must be made **at least one year in advance**. Either the bride or groom must be a registered member of our parish. Once the marriage questionnaire is completed a Parish Priest or Deacon will then contact the couple.

Eucharistic Adoration



Eucharistic Adoration is the act of worshipping God as He is present in the consecrated Eucharist. Since the Last Supper, when Jesus broke the bread and distributed the wine saying, “This is my Body” and “This is my Blood,” Catholics have believed that the bread and wine are no longer merely baked wheat and fermented grape juice, but the actual living presence of the Second Person of the Trinity—Jesus Christ. Spending time before the Blessed Sacrament, in prayer and devotion, is exactly the same as spending time before the Living God. Adoration occurs whenever someone kneels in front of a tabernacle that contains the Blessed Sacrament, genuflects toward a tabernacle, bows before receiving the Blessed Sacrament at Mass, or, in a more focused way, when the Blessed Sacrament is exposed for Adoration. **There will be no Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament for September.**

STEWARDSHIP SCRIPTURE REFLECTIONS

Twenty-First Sunday in Ordinary Time (August 23, 2026)

"Who do people say that the Son of Man is?" Matthew 16:13

The answers the disciples gave to Jesus' question varied because they recognized some of the attributes of individual prophets in Jesus. Peter saw what the Messiah was supposed to be because Jesus reflected who He was. A steward reflects generosity and this is immediately recognizable to all that he meets.

OCIA (Order of Christian Initiation of Adults)



August 23, 2026 - Twenty-first Sunday in Ordinary Time - Built on a Rock of Faith

On the 21st Sunday in Ordinary Time, we hear about strength, trust, and responsibility. God chooses people for His work and gives them what they need to carry it out. Each reading shows how God works through others to guide His people. Isaiah tells of Shebna losing his role and Eliakim being raised up instead. God chooses Eliakim and gives him real authority. He becomes like a peg, steady and trusted, holding up his family and his people. In the Gospel, Jesus gives Peter a new mission. Peter recognizes Jesus as the Son of God. Jesus responds by giving him the keys of the kingdom and calling him the rock on which the Church will stand. This reading helps us reflect on faith and leadership. The readings this Sunday, calls us to think about who we trust and follow. God is always working, even when we don't fully understand. He gives strength and purpose to those who say yes to Him. 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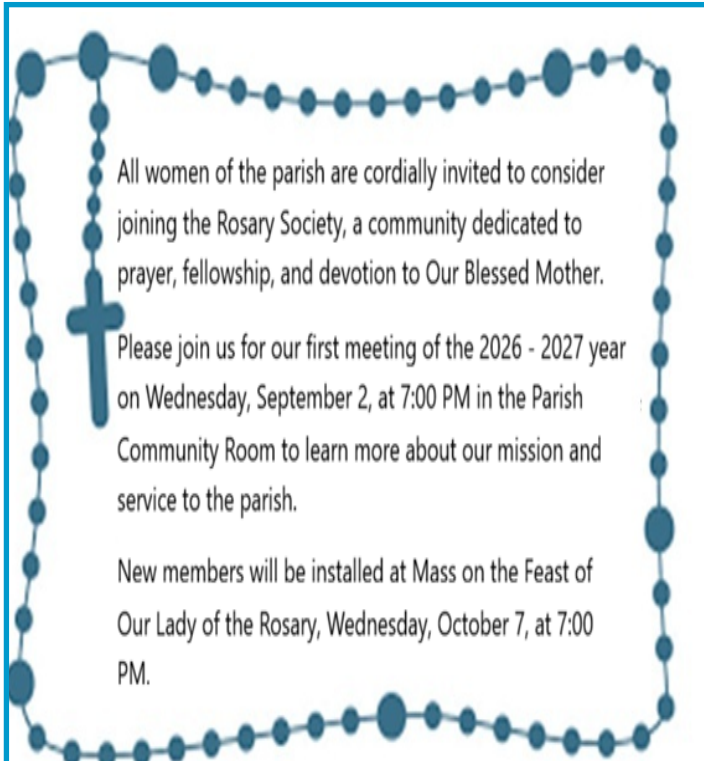
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All women of the parish are cordially invited to consider joining the Rosary Society, a community dedicated to prayer, fellowship, and devotion to Our Blessed Mother.

The world-famous International Pilgrim Virgin Statue of Our Lady of Fatima, traveling the world since 1947, will visit St. Thomas the Apostle on September 21st, 2026, from 4-8pm.

The statue was sculpted by José Thedim according to the instructions of Sister Lucia, one of the three shepherd children of Fatima, and was blessed by the Bishop of Leiria-Fatima on October 13, 1947. Since then, it has traveled to more than 100 countries, bringing Our Lady's message of prayer, conversion, and peace to millions of people.

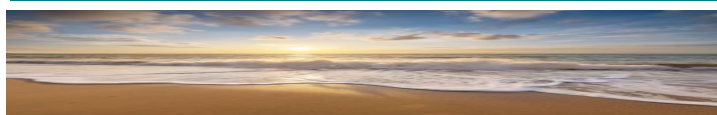

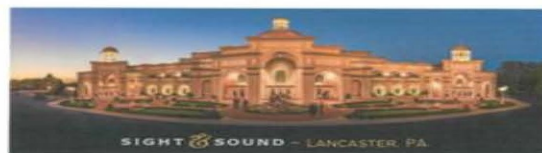
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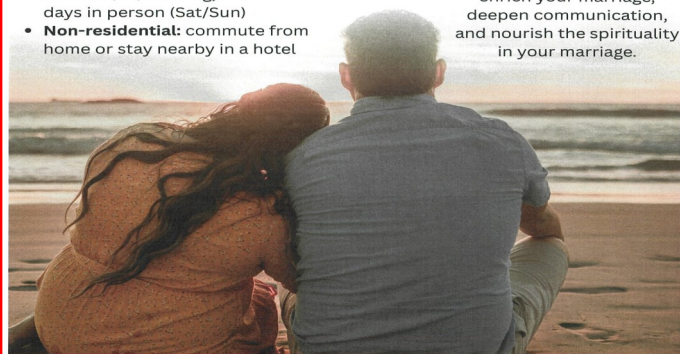
