BAPTISMS:

Arrangements must be made **at least one year in advance**. Either the bride or groom must be a registered member of our parish. Once the marriage questionnaire is completed a Parish Priest or Deacon will then contact the couple.

Eucharistic Adoration



Eucharistic Adoration is the act of worshipping God as He is present in the consecrated Eucharist. Since the Last Supper, when Jesus broke the bread and distributed the wine saying, "This is my Body" and "This is my Blood," Catholics have believed that the bread and wine are no longer merely baked wheat and fermented grape juice, but the actual living presence of the Second Person of the Trinity—Jesus Christ. Adoration occurs whenever someone kneels in front of a tabernacle that contains the Blessed Sacrament, genuflects toward a tabernacle, bows before receiving the Blessed Sacrament at Mass, or, in a more focused way, when the Blessed Sacrament is exposed for Adoration. **There will be no Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament for September.**

OCIA (Order of Christian Initiation of Adults)



August 30, 2026 - Twenty-Second Sunday in Ordinary Time - Following Christ with Courage

The 22nd Sunday in Ordinary Time invites us to look closely at what it means to follow Jesus. The readings show that God's call is not always easy. Jeremiah speaks of a fire in his heart that he cannot hold back, even when others laugh at him. God's word is alive and cannot be silenced. Paul, in his letter to the Romans, calls us to offer our lives to God. He tells us not to copy the ways of the world but to be renewed in mind and spirit. This is how we learn what pleases God. It is a call to live each day with faith and courage. In the Gospel, Jesus tells His followers to deny themselves and take up their crosses. He warns that gaining the world is nothing if we lose our souls. In the readings this Sunday, we are asked to choose the way of Christ, even when it is hard. It is the path that leads to true life.
